Today – Largely dry in the morning with a slight chance of an isolated shower/t-storm developing in the area. A higher chance of activity develops between 12pm-4pm. Some of these storms may be strong to severe with damaging wind gusts and locally heavy rainfall. Winds will be generally light and variable today, becoming easterly to southerly at times in the afternoon.

Rainfall: 0.25-0.50", with locally higher amounts in storms.

Extended forecast – Saturday, scattered shower/t-storm increase as an area of low pressure moves into the region, with the highest coverage of activity focusing the afternoon/evening. Some of these storms may be strong with damaging wind gusts and heavy rainfall the main threats. Winds Saturday will be variable to southwesterly, generally under 15 mph. Sunday, with an area of low pressure lingering in the area, scattered shower/t-storm risks remain, especially in the afternoon. Winds on Sunday become westerly, with gusts to 15-18 mph expected.
