This afternoon – Dry conditions continue this afternoon with high temperatures reaching the upper 80s to low 90s. Wind direction remains variable to northeasterly as the area continues to be influenced by a lake breeze off Lake Michigan. Mostly dry conditions are expected much of the night but can't completely rule out a few showers or an isolated thunderstorm in the area after 4am Friday.

Extended forecast – Primary threats on Friday will be high temperatures in the low-mid 90s along with increased thunderstorm chances. For now, there is a lesser chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms early Friday morning, with increased chances during the late afternoon/evening hours. Forecast confidence remains lowest in specific timing and intensity of thunderstorms Friday as subtle small-scale features can have a high impact on timing and intensity of storms. On Saturday and Sunday, temperatures look to return to more seasonal values in the low 80s with lessening precipitation chances.
