

Extended forecast – A disturbance will allow a broken line of showers/T-storms to develop over central Nebraska this evening with this activity pushing towards Omaha overnight. The forecast will maintain dry conditions Friday/Saturday, although a low threat for T-storms may have to be mentioned in future updates. A more substantial threat for showers/T-storms likely develops on Sunday, however timing out the period of greatest concern remains difficult, currently.
