Extended forecast – Moisture and instability will increase tonight into Saturday, although the greatest overlap is expected to remain east of Nashville. Regardless, showers will become possible late tonight with increasing coverage during the day Saturday. The lightning chance will be kept around 25% with the period between 10am-4pm favored. The threat for showers could persist through Saturday night into Sunday morning as the main piece of upper-level energy moves through.
