Today – Dry conditions are forecast through the early afternoon under mostly sunny to partly cloudy skies. A weakening cold front currently working across the Florida Peninsula may generate a thin band of showers and potentially a few embedded thunderstorms some 40+ miles to the northwest of the Abaco Club from 3-6pm. Any shower activity out ahead of this boundary will be isolated across Central Abaco this afternoon. This weak cold front is forecast to move across Great Abaco this evening, with a thin band of scattered showers expected to move through between 7-10pm. Breezy south-southwesterly winds will gradually turn west-southwesterly late in the day out ahead of the weak cold front.

Extended forecast – There will be an isolated chance for a passing ocean shower Tuesday afternoon as breezy northeasterly winds turn east-northeasterly. A round of intermittent showers are possible Wednesday morning as a pocket of moisture rotates through the northwestern Bahamas, with activity likely to become isolated by early Wednesday afternoon. A cold front will arrive late Thursday, bringing scattered showers and isolated thunderstorm potential Thursday evening into early Friday.
