Today – Moisture from the remnants of the frontal boundary that passed through Monday evening is lifting back northward this morning and will bring a round of showers to start the day – some of which will produce pockets of heavy rain. Activity should become more intermittent by mid-morning before turning isolated in coverage this afternoon as this area of elevated moisture lifts north of Great Abaco. Breezy southeasterly winds will turn south-southeasterly this afternoon, sustained at 14-20 mph with gusts in the 20-25 mph range. The temperature will top out in the upper 70s.

Tomorrow – Partly cloudy with an isolated passing shower becoming possible after 3pm out ahead of a cold front set to pass across Great Abaco Thursday evening. Southwesterly winds will turn westerly towards sunset. **Sunrise: 6:55am / Sunset: 5:47pm**
