Today – A mix of sun and clouds are anticipated for much of the day. There is a threat for shower development this afternoon but this activity likely favors areas closer to the coast. Winds are tricky as there is potential for a lull in velocity this morning before increasing again by the early afternoon. Overall, peak wind speeds are likely weaker than the previous days, with sustained winds generally under 15 mph and gusts in the lower 20s. **Sunrise: 6:39am / Sunset: 6:24pm**

Extended forecast – Moisture levels will hold steady through the weekend with stronger northerly winds becoming reestablished. The combination of brisk flow and higher moisture may allow showers to track over the mountains, especially on Saturday. Sustained winds in the 10-20 mph range are expected each day with gusts of 25-30 mph. The shower threat may increase on Monday as flow becomes lighter and moisture levels rise.
