Extended forecast – A brief shower can't be completely ruled out during the day Saturday, with slightly higher chances of showers and potentially an isolated thunderstorm Saturday evening/night as a weak cold front moves through the Raleigh area. Temperatures continue to increase on Saturday, potentially reaching the mid to upper 80s. Slightly cooler temperatures are expected on Sunday behind the cold front, with highs in the low-mid 70s. Winds are expected to remain mainly out of the east-northeast this weekend, with the breeziest conditions expected Sunday with gusts to 15-20 mph across susceptible wind-prone areas.
