Today – Rain showers, moderate to heavy at times, moves through this morning, mainly between 7-10am, though some isolated activity will linger later through the morning. Largely dry and turning partly cloudy for the afternoon, though an isolated shower/t-storm still cannot be ruled out. Highs will reach near 80F late this afternoon and lows tonight fall to 63F.

Rainfall through tonight: 0.25-0.50", locally higher in storms.

Extended forecast – Friday, a drier airmass will build in leading to largely dry and partly cloudy conditions, though an isolated afternoon shower/t-storm will remain possible over the mountains. Saturday, a few more isolated showers/t-storms are possible, mainly in the afternoon, but most valley areas remain dry. Drier air builds in again for Sunday with dry weather expected to hold in the valley and a few afternoon t-storms over the mountains.
