Extended forecast – Blustery winds continue to a lesser degree on Saturday, gusting between 20-25 mph after 9am as a front slowly approaches Central Florida. Isolated showers Saturday morning will see a slight increase in coverage Saturday afternoon as the boundary draws closer. An isolated, brief heavy shower may occur Saturday afternoon, along with a 10% risk for a stray weak thunderstorm. The front will move through overnight Saturday before stalling just south of the area for Sunday. Northerly winds and cooler temperatures are forecast on Sunday, along with isolated pop-up shower chances prior to 8am and again after 1pm due to the boundary lingering to our south.
