Today – There is a slight chance that patches of fog may drift in from the west this morning, but any reduction in visibility will improve by 8:30am. Otherwise expect dry conditions under mostly sunny to partly cloudy skies. South-southwesterly winds will increase to 10-15 mph this afternoon. The temperature will reach a high near 87°F.

Extended forecast – Windy conditions are expected after 10am Friday, becoming sustained at 17-22 mph with gusts of 25-30 mph through the afternoon before decreasing slightly after 5-6pm. Blustery winds continue to a lesser degree on Saturday, gusting in the 20-25 mph range after 9am as a frontal boundary stalls out over north-central Florida. A few showers may occur out ahead of the front on Saturday, but heavier rains and afternoon thunderstorm potential is forecast to remain northwest of Orlando and closer to the stalled boundary. The front passes through overnight into early Sunday, bringing isolated shower chances prior to 8am. Northerly winds and cooler temperatures are forecast for the remainder of Sunday.
