Things to Know

- World No. 2 and Dallas resident Scottie Scheffler holds a one-stroke lead after the second round of the AT&T Byron Nelson
- Scheffler, who has two wins this season, would return to No. 1 in the Official World Golf Ranking with a victory
- For the second consecutive year at the AT&T Byron Nelson, Ryan Palmer ties his career-low opening 36-hole score (129)
- Three of the top four players on the leaderboard have won this season (Scheffler, Mackenzie Hughes, Si Woo Kim)
- Two-time defending champion K.H. Lee and 2018 champion Aaron Wise make the cut on the number (-4)

- 9 Second-round leaders/co-leaders to win the AT&T Byron Nelson since 2000 (most recent: Sung Kang/2019)
- 9 Second-round leaders/co-leaders to win individual stroke-play events on TOUR in 2022-23 (most recent: Wyndham Clark/Wells Fargo Championship)

- Seventh career 36-hole lead/co-lead (2-for-6 to date) and second this season (Won/WM Phoenix Open)
- Ties Patrick Cantlay for most 36-hole leads/co-leads on TOUR since the start of Scheffler's rookie season (2019-20)
- Records second-lowest opening 36-hole score of PGA TOUR career (128); lowest: 127, 2019 Greenbrier Classic (finished T7)
- Fourth player to card a 64 or better in each of the first two rounds of a TOUR event this season (two of previous three went on to win)

- Would return to No. 1 in the Official World Golf Ranking with a victory (most recently lost the No. 1 position after Jon Rahm won the Masters Tournament)
- Trails Jon Rahm by 1,076 in the FedExCup standings (will remain No. 2 entering the PGA Championship regardless of finish)
- Making fifth start at the AT&T Byron Nelson, site of his PGA TOUR debut as a 17-year-old amateur in 2014 (T22); results at TPC Craig Ranch: T47 (2021) and T15 (2022)

Miscellaneous Notes

- Ryan Palmer (T2/-13) ties his career-low opening 36-hole score on TOUR at 129 (third occasion): 2014 American Express (finished 2nd), 2022 AT&T Byron Nelson (T5), 2023 AT&T Byron Nelson; Palmer held a share of the 36-hole lead at the event in 2022 before finishing T5, his most recent top-10 on TOUR
- Six players in the field have won on TOUR this season, and three of those six are in the top four on the leaderboard: Scheffler/1st (WM Phoenix Open and THE PLAYERS Championship), Mackenzie Hughes/T2 (Sanderson Farms Championship) and Si Woo Kim/4th (Sony Open in Hawaii); four players have won multiple titles this season: Jon Rahm (4), Tony Finau (2), Max Homa (2) and Scheffler (2)
- Two-time defending champion **K.H. Lee**, 2018 champion **Aaron Wise** (making first start since the 2023 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play) and sponsor exemption **David Micheluzzi** make the cut on the number
