K.H. Lee earned 500 FedExCup points and his second career TOUR Victory at the 2022 AT&T Byron Nelson. Lee became the fourth player to successfully defend an AT&T Byron Nelson title; joined Sam Snead, Jack Nicklaus, and Tom Watson.

Comcast Business TOUR Top 10 & FedExCup Storylines

- 5th** Wyndham Clark moved into the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 with his win at the Wells Fargo Championship (5th), marking his highest rank in the FedExCup in his TOUR career and first week in the TOUR TOP 10
- 5** Clark is the fifth player to win the Wells Fargo Championship and move into the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 since 2015 (*Mcllroy/2015, Harman/2017, Day/2018, Homa/2022*)
- 2** Wyndham Clark and Xander Schauffele moved into the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 last week at the Wells Fargo Championship, marking one of four events in the 2023 calendar year where multiple players moved inside the TOUR TOP 10
