**Today** – Some lingering shower and isolated T-storm activity may affect the McKinney area between 9am-12pm. Otherwise a brief period of dry conditions are favored through the early afternoon. Areas of showers/T-storms should eventually develop after 3-5pm, with the greatest threat favoring the early evening hours. Temperatures should reach the lower 80s with south to southeast winds generally under 15 mph. Forecast rainfall: 0.20-0.40” with localized higher amounts likely. **Sunrise: 6:28am / Sunset: 8:18pm**

**Tomorrow** – Unsettled conditions to persist across Texas during the day Sunday with an increasing threat for showers/T-storms as the day progresses. Showers/T-storms can't be ruled out Sunday morning, however coverage will be limited. With daytime heating, showers/T-storms should eventually become more numerous in the afternoon, especially after 3pm. Temperatures will reach the lower 80s with light southeast winds in place. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.25” with localized higher amounts likely. **Sunrise: 6:28am / Sunset: 8:18pm**
