Today – Intermittent showers are likely out ahead of a frontal boundary this morning – moderate in intensity at times through 10am before turning scattered and lighter towards midday. Anticipate a decreasing trend in light showers this afternoon under mostly cloudy skies. Strong winds are currently holding offshore of the Monterey Peninsula, but breezy to windy conditions could periodically occur through late morning before winds slacken and turn east-northeasterly this afternoon. High temp: 57°F.

Extended forecast – Mostly cloudy skies, light winds and dry conditions are likely overnight. An isolated light shower or area of drizzle may occur after 10am Saturday, with a few showers becoming possible after 3pm. Windy conditions return across exposed areas around 12pm Saturday out ahead of another cold front set to arrive Saturday night. Rain is likely overnight Saturday into Sunday morning and will continue in a scattered fashion Sunday afternoon as gusty westerly winds turn northwesterly.
