**Today** – Isolated light showers or areas of drizzle will become possible after 8am this morning, with activity increasing to a scattered coverage of light to moderate intensity showers towards the conclusion of the third round. Southerly winds will begin to increase late this morning, becoming windy by early afternoon with anticipated gusts of 30-40 mph. Higher peak gusts of **40-45 mph** are possible this evening. **Forecast rainfall through 4pm: Less than 0.10"** **Sunrise: 7:07am / Sunset: 5:37pm**

**Tonight & Tomorrow** – Moderate to briefly heavy showers Saturday evening and overnight are expected to bring an additional 0.25" – 0.50" of rainfall through 7am Sunday. Several thin, fast-moving moderate to heavy rainbands are expected to pass through Sunday morning before activity decreases in coverage and intensity for the afternoon hours. These morning rainbands will be capable of producing wind gusts of 30-35 mph as they pass through. Although unlikely, a 5-10% probability for a rogue lightning strike or brief instance of small hail will be present within the strongest portions of these morning rainbands. Additional rainfall of 0.10" – 0.25" is forecast after 7am Sunday. Outside of showers, expect that blustery westerly winds tomorrow morning will turn west-northwesterly in the afternoon, sustained at 15-20 mph with gusts near 25 mph.
