Today – Scattered showers will begin to drift into the area this morning and will gradually decrease in coverage during the afternoon as an upper level disturbance rotates above the Bay Area and Central Coast. Although the coverage of these showers may be rather sparse at times today – with long stretches of mostly sunny and dry conditions in between any areas of precipitation – these cells will be capable of producing moderate to briefly heavy rainfall. Additionally, enough instability will be present to allow for a ≤10% probability that the strongest cells produce a rogue lightning strike or instance of small hail. Stronger wind gusts of 30-35 mph may also accompany any stronger cell that develops. Outside of any showers, blustery conditions are forecast behind the cold front that passed through last night, with westerly winds turning northwesterly this afternoon at 15-25 mph along with gusts in the 25-30 mph range. **Forecast rainfall through 6pm: Less than 0.25"**
