**Third-Round Notes – Saturday, July 15, 2023**

**Weather:** Cloudy with moderate to heavy showers. High of 82. Wind SW 10-15 mph. Play was suspended due to a dangerous weather situation at 9:05 a.m. and resumed at 9:50 a.m. (delay of 45 minutes). The Barbasol Championship has experienced at least one weather delay each year since its debut in 2015.

**Third-Round Lead Notes**

- Third-round leaders/co-leaders to win the Barbasol Championship: Scott Piercy/2015, Troy Merritt/2018, Jim Herman/2019
- 20 third-round leaders/co-leaders have won in individual stroke-play events on TOUR this season (most recent: Rickie Fowler/Rocket Mortgage Classic)

**Trevor Cone (1<sup>st</sup>/-17)**

- Following a bogey-free 9-under 63, PGA TOUR rookie holds the 54-hole lead by one stroke over Lucas Glover and Vincent Norrman; marks the first time with the lead after any round in his TOUR career
- Previous low round on TOUR was 65 (2023 AT&T Byron Nelson/R4)
- Previous-best opening 54-hole score on TOUR: 204 (2023 AT&T Byron Nelson/T23)
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Off the Tee (4.581), Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (11.710) and Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (8.361)
- Best finish in 20 prior starts this season is T23 at the AT&T Byron Nelson
- Would become the season’s ninth first-time winner (first since Wyndham Clark/Wells Fargo Championship)
- Would join Scott Piercy (2015), Grayson Murray (2017) and Jim Herman (2019) as winners in their debut appearance at the Barbasol Championship
- Would become the fourth player to make the Barbasol Championship his maiden TOUR title (Murray/2017, Seamus Power/2021, Trey Mullinax/2022)
- Currently No. 194 in the FedExCup standings (top 70 players following the Wyndham Championship advance to the Playoffs)

**Additional Notes**

- First- and second-round leader **Lucas Glover** (T2/-16) posts a 3-under 69, his 11<sup>th</sup> straight round in the 60s; has back-to-back top-10 finishes at the Rocket Mortgage Classic (T4) and John Deere Classic (T6)
- With a 5-under 67, PGA TOUR rookie **Vincent Norrman** (T2/-16) records his eighth straight under-par round on TOUR; has two top-10 finishes this season (T9/Zurich Classic of New Orleans with teammate Matthias Schwab, T8/AT&T Byron Nelson)
- Frenchman **Adrien Saddier** (4<sup>th</sup>/-15) would become the first player since Jim Benepe at the 1988 Beatrice Western Open to win his first TOUR start; lone professional win came at the Challenge Tour’s 2016 Fred Olsen Challenge de Espana
- 2017 Barbasol Championship winner **Grayson Murray** (T7/-13) equals career-low round with a 9-under 63 (2017 AT&T Byron Nelson/R2); would become the event’s first multiple winner
- With a 3-under 69, Barbasol ambassador **Ryan Armour** (T14/-12) records his 20<sup>th</sup> straight par-or-better round at the event, dating to a final-round 67 at Grand National in 2015
- Preferred lies were in effect during the third round
