Today – Partly to mostly cloudy skies can be expected this morning before scattered showers and thunderstorms develop by early afternoon as a cold front moves into the area from the north. Storms could become severe this afternoon with strong, gusty winds, small hail and heavy rainfall. Showers and thunderstorms should begin to dissipate after sunset.

Extended forecast – The chance for scattered showers and thunderstorms decreases on Friday as Kentucky will be in between systems. Most locations will remain dry with partly cloudy skies and hot temperatures. The next front will move into the region Saturday increasing the chances for showers and thunderstorms once again. Storms could be strong with gusty winds and heavy rainfall. A few showers may linger into Sunday morning. Otherwise, a drier day is expected with partly cloudy skies and highs around 88F/31C.
