Scoring

The Barracuda Championship utilizes the Modified Stableford scoring format, the first PGA TOUR event to use the format since The International in 2006. Players are allocated points based on the number of strokes taken at each hole with the goal of achieving the highest overall score.

Third-Round Lead Notes

- 21 Third-round leaders/co-leaders have won in individual stroke-play events on TOUR this season (most recent: Rory McIlroy/Genesis Scottish Open)
- 14 Third-round leaders/co-leaders to win Barracuda Championship (most recent: Chez Reavie/2022)

Patrick Rodgers (1st/+34)

- Seeks first career PGA TOUR title in 246th TOUR start
- Would become the 10th first-time winner of the season on the PGA TOUR
- Six of the last seven winners of the Barracuda Championship were first-time PGA TOUR winners: 2016/Greg Chalmers, 2017/Chris Stroud, 2018/Andrew Putnam, 2019/Collin Morikawa, 2020/Richy Werenski, 2021/Erik van Rooyen
- Holds fifth 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR and second this season (Valero Texas Open/5th); 0-for-4 to date
- Has three runner-up finishes on TOUR: T2/2015 Wells Fargo Championship, 2nd/2017 John Deere Classic, P2/2018 RSM Classic
- Finished T3 at the 2022 Butterfield Bermuda Championship for his best finish in 27 starts this season
- Making his eighth start at the Barracuda Championship (best: 3rd/2015)
- Second-highest ranked player in the field at No. 53 in the FedExCup standings (highest: No. 47 Nick Hardy)

Ryan Gerard (2nd/+33)

- 36-hole leader holds seeks first career PGA TOUR title in 16th TOUR start; best career TOUR finish: 4th/2023 Honda Classic
- Making his tournament debut; last player to win in Barracuda Championship debut: Erik van Rooyen/2021
- Playing out of Special Temporary Member category this season

- To earn full status on the PGA TOUR for the 2024 season via non-member FedExCup points, must earn as many or more points as No. 125 in the final 2022-23 FedExCup Playoffs and Eligibility Points List; Gerard has 251 points, which would fall between Nos. 129 and 130 in the FedExCup Playoffs and Eligibility Points List
