(Second of three FedExCup Playoffs events)

Olympia Fields, Illinois August 17-20, 2023 FedExCup Points: 2,000 (winner)

First-Round Notes – Thursday, August 17, 2023

**Weather**: Due to thunderstorms, the start of the first round was delayed for two hours and began at 10:26 a.m. CT. Partly cloudy and breezy. High of 78. Wind NW 12-18 mph, with gusts to 30 mph.

# Rory McIlroy (T1/-5)

- Holds the first-round lead/co-lead for the fifth time at the BMW Championship, the most of any player at any PGA TOUR event on record (1983-present): 2012/won, 2014/T8, 2018/5<sup>th</sup>, 2021/4<sup>th</sup>, 2023/TBD
- Marks his 21<sup>st</sup> career 18-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR, the most of any player since his professional debut on TOUR in 2009; is 3-for-20 converting the first-round lead/co-lead to victory (2011 U.S. Open, 2012 BMW Championship, 2014 Open Championship)
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (3.603)
- Enters the week at No. 3 in the FedExCup as he seeks his fourth FedExCup title (2016, 2019, 2022)
- In search of his 25<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR victory and third of the season (THE CJ CUP in South Carolina, Genesis Scottish Open)
- Has six top-10 finishes in 12 prior BMW Championship starts, including a win in 2012

### Brian Harman (T1/-5)

- Holds the first-round lead/co-lead for the third time on the PGA TOUR; is 1-for-2 to date converting to victory (2014 John Deere Classic/won, 2014 RSM Classic/T41)
- Leads the field in Proximity to the hole (22'6")
- Best finish in nine prior BMW Championship starts is T12 in 2020 at Olympia Fields Country Club
- Enters the week at No. 9 in the FedExCup as he seeks to become the first player to win The Open Championship and FedExCup in the same season

### **First-Round Lead Notes**

- 8 First-round leaders/co-leaders to win the BMW Championship since 2000 (most recent: Justin Thomas/2019)
- First-round leaders/co-leaders to win individual stroke-play events on TOUR in 2022-23 (most recent: Lee Hodges/3M Open)

## **Miscellaneous Notes**

- Highlighted by the longest hole-out of his PGA TOUR career (167 yards for eagle on the par-4 14<sup>th</sup> hole), Sahith Theegala
  (T3) opens with a 4-under 66
- 2023 Rocket Mortgage Classic winner **Rickie Fowler** (T3/-4) posts his 16<sup>th</sup> consecutive par-or-better round at the BMW Championship; currently No. 12 in the FedExCup, looking to advance to the TOUR Championship for the first time since 2019
- Following wins in each of the last two weeks (Wyndham Championship, FedEx St. Jude Championship), Lucas Glover

(T23/E) is seeking to become the first player to win three consecutive weeks on TOUR since Tiger Woods in 2006 (PGA Championship, WGC-Bridgestone Invitational, Deutsche Bank Championship)

- Additional notable opening-round scores:
  - World No. 1 and 2023 PLAYERS champion Scottie Scheffler (T3/66/-4)
  - o 2023 U.S. Open champion Wyndham Clark (T3/66/-4)
  - o FedExCup leader Jon Rahm (T12/68/-2)
  - o 2021 and 2022 BMW Championship winner **Patrick Cantlay** (T12/68/-2); the last player to win the same event three straight years is Steve Stricker at the John Deere Classic (2009, 2010, 2011)
