

## Standout Statistics

### 2023 FedExCup Playoffs

<b>17<sup>th</sup></b>	Season in the FedExCup era
<b>61 / 36</b>	Total FedExCup Playoff events, won by 36 different winners in the 17 <sup>th</sup> season of the FedExCup
<b>17,004</b>	The total number of rounds played with scores ranging from 59 to 86 in the FedExCup Playoffs
<b>306,072</b>	The total number of holes played with scores ranging from 1 to 11 in the FedExCup Playoffs
<b>1,195,650</b>	Total strokes in the FedExCup Playoffs since 2007 (-8,333 total score to par)
<b>443</b>	The number of different players who have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs at least once. These 443 players represent 31 different countries.
<b>95.7%</b>	This season, 95.7% of the players (76 of 70) who qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs have only known the FedExCup compared to 9.0% in the inaugural season (2007).
<b>96.70%</b>	of players to qualify for the TOUR Championship last season only knew the FedExCup. Last season, 29 of the 30 players who qualified for the TOUR Championship have only known the FedExCup era.
<b>10</b>	Every player who has finished in the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 has qualified for the TOUR Championship since 2009
<b>1</b>	Matt Kuchar is the only player to qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs in all 17 seasons
<b>188</b>	The number of different players who have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs at least 5 times
<b>8</b>	Eight players with 10 or more top-five finishes in the FedExCup Playoffs
<b>6</b>	Six of the last nine FedExCup Playoffs have seen 20 or more different countries represented
<b>4</b>	Four players have more than two wins in the FedExCup Playoffs (Dustin Johnson/6, Rory McIlroy/6, Tiger Woods/4 & Patrick Cantlay/3)
<b>2</b>	Two players have shot 59 in the FedExCup Playoffs (Jim Furyk, 2013 BMW Championship, 2 <sup>nd</sup> Rd & Scottie Scheffler, 2020 FedEx St. Jude Championship, 2 <sup>nd</sup> Rd)
<b>2</b>	Tiger Woods (2007, 2009) and Rory McIlroy (2016, 2019 & 2022) are the only two players to win multiple FedExCup titles.
<b>1</b>	Patrick Cantlay became the first player to successfully defend a title of a FedExCup Playoffs event (with victory at 2022 BMW Championship)
