**Today** – A line of showers/T-storms will move through Olympia Fields between 8:15-9:15am. Once this passes, a low threat (15-25%) for a shower/T-storm will exist until the cold front clears the area between 12-2pm. Southwest winds will switch to the northwest behind the front and remain brisk with gusts of 25-30 mph possible much of the afternoon. Forecast rainfall: 0.15-0.30 with localized amounts up to 0.50".

**Extended forecast** – High pressure will build over the center of the country with dry and gradually warming conditions expected over northern Illinois. This high may weaken slightly Sunday into Monday with Lake Michigan potentially influencing winds and temperatures. A 10% chance for precipitation will be included in the forecast for both days as well. As long as winds remain southerly, temperatures will approach 90 degrees by the end of the weekend.
