Weather: Thursday: Partly cloudy. High of 84. Wind SE 6-12 mph. The first round was suspended due to darkness at 5:36 p.m. CT with 13 players left to complete their round. Friday: Partly cloudy with a slight chance of thunderstorms. High of 82. Wind SW 8-15 mph. The first round resumed at 7:40 a.m. and was completed at 8:14 a.m. The second round began as scheduled at 6:40 a.m.

Additional Player Notes

- Tyson Alexander (T4/-4) seeks his first career PGA TOUR title in his eighth TOUR start (best: T44/Butterfield Bermuda Championship); earned his first PGA TOUR card via the 2022 Korn Ferry Tour Regular Season and became the first player in Korn Ferry Tour history to successfully defend a title, winning the 2021 and 2022 Veritex Bank Championship at Texas Rangers Golf Club in Arlington, Texas
- Mackenzie Hughes (T4/-4) seeks to become the first multiple winner this season (2022 Sanderson Farms Championship)
- In his third PGA TOUR start, 22-year-old amateur **Travis Vick** (-2) from Houston, Texas is playing on a sponsor exemption; the University of Texas senior seeks to become first amateur to win on TOUR since Phil Mickelson (1991 Northern Telecom Open)
- Lee Hodges (-1) holes out from 212 yards at No. 1, recording the longest hole-out of his career and longest on TOUR since Mito Pereira (273/2022 Memorial Tournament presented by Workday/R4/No. 7)
- Winner of last week's World Wide Technology Championship at Mayakoba, 2017 Cadence Bank Houston Open winner Russell Henley (+2) is making his 250th career start on the PGA TOUR this week; the last player to win back-to-back weeks on the TOUR schedule is Tony Finau (3M Open, Rocket Mortgage Classic in 2022)
