### Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

Charles Schwab Challenge

Sam Burns earned 500 FedExCup points and his fourth career PGA TOUR victory at the 2022 Charles Schwab Challenge. Burns has had 31 weeks inside the FedExCup Top-3 in the last two PGA TOUR seasons, the most of any player during that time.

**7** Burns trailed by seven entering the final round, tying the largest final round comeback by a Charles Schwab Challenge winner (1994 Nick Price) and by a PGA TOUR winner in the last two seasons on TOUR (2022 PGA Championship, Justin Thomas & 2023 Sentry TOC, Jon Rahm)

**+7.28** Final round Strokes Gained: Total, the second most by a winner since the start of the 2021-22 PGA TOUR Season

**+4.11** gained over four strokes in SG: Putting in the final round, including a perfect 16 of 16 from inside 10 feet & 18 of 19 inside 15 feet

**66.67** percentage of outs made from 5-15', the fourth highest percentage of any event in his PGA TOUR career
