Today – Cloud cover will increase for the last few hours of play as an area of showers to the west of Colonial Country Club decays. A stray pop-up shower cannot be ruled out late this afternoon or into the early evening prior to dry conditions taking over for tonight. The temperature has peaked near 86°F this afternoon and will fall back into the mid-60s overnight. Easterly winds will decrease and turn east-southeasterly late this evening. **Sunrise: 6:25am / Sunset: 8:29pm**

Extended forecast – Isolated afternoon and early evening pop-up showers and weak thunderstorms will pose a low threat this weekend, with the highest chances forecast after 2pm Sunday afternoon. The weather pattern will continue to promote afternoon and evening thunderstorms across the Panhandle and Big Bend Country regions of Texas through the weekend, with this activity likely to grow upscale into thunderstorm complexes during the evening hours each day. This organized activity will then drift off to the south-southeast during the overnight and early morning hours but is forecast to remain well to the west of Colonial Country Club on Saturday and Sunday.
