Tomorrow – A complex of thunderstorms will develop over the Panhandle region of Texas Saturday night but is forecast to largely decay and likely dissipate west of the DFW Metroplex early Sunday morning. Isolated showers and thunderstorms may yet develop to the east of this decaying complex Sunday morning, with scattered showers and a few thunderstorms becoming possible Sunday afternoon. Activity will become isolated once again by 6-7pm Sunday evening. Temperatures will top out in the mid-80s. Winds become southerly at 7-13 mph Sunday afternoon with a few gusts to 15 mph additionally possible. **Forecast rainfall: 0.10" – 0.25".**Sunrise: 6:24am / Sunset: 8:30pm
