Things to Know

- Max Homa comes from five strokes back to win his sixth PGA TOUR title and fourth in his native state California
- Homa's last five wins have been in come-from-behind fashion
- Keegan Bradley (2nd) becomes the first player on TOUR this season to record a win and runner-up this season
- After holding at least a share of the lead each of the first three rounds, Sam Ryder finishes T4
- After wins in each of his last two starts, FedExCup leader Jon Rahm (T7) earns his fourth top-10 in four starts to begin the season

- Earns his sixth career victory in his 156th start at the age of 32 years, 2 months, 9 days
- Collects 500 points and moves into the No. 2 spot in the FedExCup standings
- Becomes the second multiple winner on TOUR this season (Jon Rahm earned his second victory of the season at last week's American Express)
- Second consecutive season with multiple victories (2021-22)
- Four of six wins have come in his native state of California (2021 Genesis Invitational, 2021 and 2022 Fortinet Championship, 2023 Farmers Insurance Open)
- Ties Jon Rahm (4) for the most wins on TOUR in California since the start of the 2016-17 season
- Entered the final round of the Farmers Insurance Open trailing Sam Ryder by five strokes; last five wins have been in comefrom-behind fashion
- Led the field in Strokes Gained: Tee To Green (10.620) and Strokes Gained: Approach The Green (8.387)
- Becomes the fifth player with multiple victories since the start of the 2018-19 season

Miscellaneous notes

- **Keegan Bradley** (2nd/-11) ties his low score in 44 rounds at the Farmers Insurance Open (66) to finish his best finish in 12 starts at Torrey Pines; with a win at the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP in the fall, becomes the first player on TOUR this season with a win and runner-up
- In his first start since losing a six-shot 54-hole lead at the Sentry Tournament of Champions (2nd) **Collin Morikawa** finished third in his second tournament start (T21/2020)
- Entering the final round with a two-shot lead, his first on TOUR, **Sam Ryder** closed with a 3-over 75 to finish T4; was in search of his first PGA TOUR victory in his 147th career start
- Two-time Farmers Insurance Open winner **Jason Day** (T7/-8) records second consecutive top-10 and seventh overall at the event
- Entering the week with wins in his last two starts, **Jon Rahm** closes with a 2-over 74 to finish T7; the 2017 Farmers Insurance Open champion earned sixth top-10 in seven tournament appearances
- Defending champion **Luke List** finished T25; last player to win consecutive Farmers Insurance Opens was Tiger Woods (2005-08)
