Jordan Spieth (1st/-7)

- 13th career 18-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR and first since the 2023 Sony Open in Hawaii (MC); converted the victory on three occasions: 2015 Masters Tournament, 2017 Travelers Championship, 2017 Open Championship
- Bogey-free 63 marks his lowest first-round score on TOUR this season
- Ties his lowest score in 15 career rounds at TPC Southwind (R3/2021 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational)
- Three career top-10s in the first FedExCup Playoffs event, including a runner-up finish in 2017 at Glen Oaks Club
- One career victory in a FedExCup Playoffs event: 2015 TOUR Championship
- Enters the week at No. 31 in the FedExCup after six top-10s this season; seeks his third consecutive TOUR Championship appearance
- Making 11th consecutive FedExCup Playoffs appearance; has finished inside the top 15 in the final FedExCup standings six times

Miscellaneous Notes

- Making his first start since a T2 at The Open Championship, **Tom Kim** (2nd/-6) opens with a 64, his lowest first-round score in 41 career starts on TOUR; T2 position is the highest of his career after 18 holes on TOUR (previous: T3/2022 THE CJ CUP in South Carolina)
- Making his second FedExCup Playoffs appearance, Kim earned one victory (2022 Shriners Children's Open) and six other top-10s in 2022-23; finished T13 at the 2022 FedEx St. Jude Championship
- Entering the week at No. 22 in the FedExCup, **Collin Morikawa** (T3/-5) cards 5-under 65 for his fifth consecutive round in the 60s at the FedEx St. Jude Championship; finished T5 in 2022, his best career finish in a FedExCup Playoffs event
- Emiliano Grillo (T3/-5) begins the FedExCup Playoffs with top-10 finishes in his two most recent starts (T6/The Open Championship, T10/3M Open); collected career-high seven top-10s during the regular season, including his victory at the Charles Schwab Challenge
- Last week's Wyndham Championship winner **Lucas Glover** (T5/-4) opens with a 66; entered the Wyndham Championship at No. 112 in the FedExCup and is projected No. 35 after round one of the FedEx St. Jude Championship
- FedExCup leader Jon Rahm (T65/+3) opens with an over-par score in back-to-back starts (74/The Open Championship/T2); has not opened with an over-par score in back-to-back starts on TOUR since 2018: FedEx St. Jude Championship (75/MC), Dell Technologies Championship (73/T43)
