Lucas Glover (1st/-10)

- Holds 10th career 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR in; is 0-for-9 converting to victory
- Five-time PGA TOUR winner seeks back-to-back titles after winning last week's Wyndham Championship; last player to win back-to-back on TOUR: Tony Finau (2022/3M Open, 2022/Rocket Mortgage Classic)
- 130 total marks one stroke shy of matching his low 36-hole total on TOUR (2010 Wyndham Championship/7th)
- Bogey-free 64 marks his sixth consecutive round in the 60s at TPC Southwind during the FedEx St. Jude Championship
- Best finish at the FedEx St. Jude Championship: T3/2022; marks his best finish in a FedExCup Playoffs event
- Records his lowest score in 44 rounds at TPC Southwind (previous best: 65/R1/2022 FedEx St. Jude Championship)
- Second-round 64 is his 20th consecutive round of par or better on TOUR
- Enters the week at No. 49 in the FedExCup and is projected No. 3 after round two of the FedEx St. Jude Championship

Miscellaneous Notes

- In his 11th consecutive FedExCup Playoffs appearance, **Jordan Spieth** (2nd/-9) posts a second-round 68
- Spieth has recorded three career top-10s in the first FedExCup Playoffs event, including a runner-up finish in 2017 at Glen Oaks Club; owns one career victory in a FedExCup Playoffs event: 2015 TOUR Championship
- Enters the week at No. 32 in the FedExCup, **Sungjae Im** (T3/-8) cards second-round 65; collected seven top-10s during the regular season, highlighted by a T4 finish at the Farmers Insurance Open; seeks fifth consecutive start at the TOUR Championship
- **Taylor Moore** (T3/-8) posts second-round 4-under 66 in second start at the FedEx St. Jude Championship; earned one victory (Valspar Championship) and two other top-10 finishes this season
- Making his fourth appearance at the FedEx St. Jude Championship, Tommy Fleetwood (T3/-8) posts back-to-back 66s;
 finished T4 at the 2019 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational
- Emiliano Grillo (T3/-8) begins the FedExCup Playoffs with top-10 finishes in his two most recent starts (T6/The Open Championship, T10/3M Open); collected career-high seven top-10s during the regular season, including his victory at the Charles Schwab Challenge
- Making his first start since a T2 at The Open Championship, **Tom Kim** (T3/-8) posts bogey-free 68 and is T3 in his second FedExCup Playoffs appearance (T13/2022)
- In his first start since a T2 at The Open Championship, FedExCup leader **Jon Rahm (T51/E)** posts a 3-under 67; has finished in the top-10 in five of six previous starts at the FedEx St. Jude Championship

The top-50 players at the conclusion of the FedEx St. Jude Championship will advance to the BMW Championship.
