Lucas Glover (1st/-14)

- Fifth career 54-hole lead/co-lead and is 1-for-4 converting the victory (2023 Wyndham Championship)
- First player to hold the 54-hole lead in back-to-back weeks on TOUR since Patrick Cantlay (2021 BMW Championship, TOUR Championship)
- At 43 years old, becomes the first player to hold the 54-hole lead at 40 or older in the FedExCup Playoffs since Tiger Woods (42 years, 2018 TOUR Championship)
- Five-time TOUR winner seeks back-to-back titles after winning last week's Wyndham Championship; last player to win back-to-back on TOUR: Tony Finau (2022/3M Open, 2022/Rocket Mortgage Classic)
- 54-hole total of 196 ties the second-lowest of his TOUR career (192/2023 Wyndham Championship)
- Third-round 66 is his 21st consecutive round of par or better on TOUR, with 20 of his last 21 in the 60s
- Marks his seventh consecutive round in the 60s at TPC Southwind during the FedEx St. Jude Championship
- Best finish at the FedEx St. Jude Championship: T3/2022; marks his best finish in a FedExCup Playoffs event
- Enters the week at No. 49 in the FedExCup and is currently projected No. 3
- Career-high finish in the FedExCup: 17th (2009); seeks to advance to the TOUR Championship for the third time in his 13th Playoffs appearance (last: 2019)

Miscellaneous Notes

- Making his second FedExCup Playoffs appearance, **Taylor Moore** (2nd/-13) cards a 65 and leads the field in Greens in Regulation Percentage at 75.93% (41/54) through three rounds; earned maiden PGA TOUR title at the Valspar Championship alongside two other top-10s this season (T4/Zurich Classic of New Orleans; T4/Rocket Mortgage Classic)
- **Tommy Fleetwood** (3rd/-12) posts his third consecutive 66 and seeks to join Will Zalatoris (2022 FedEx St. Jude Championship) and Camilo Villegas (2018 BMW Championship) as players to win their first PGA TOUR title in a FedExCup Playoffs event; finished top 10 in four of his last five starts on TOUR, including a runner-up at the RBC Canadian Open
- **Max Homa** (T4/-11) posts bogey-free 65 to sit inside the top five through 54 holes on TOUR for the first time since The Genesis Invitational (2nd/finished 2nd); has finished no higher than T42 in six previous starts at TPC Southwind (2022 FedEx St. Jude Championship)
- Seeking his first TOUR title since the 2022 RBC Heritage, **Jordan Spieth** (T4/-11) cards a 68 while holing only 57' 7" of putts in round three; 2015 FedExCup Champion owns five top-five finishes this season, including a runner-up in his title defense at the RBC Heritage
- **Justin Rose** (T23/-6) needed 21 putts to post a bogey-free 9-under 61, tying the course record set by Tom Lewis (R3/2020), Bob Estes (R1/2001) and Jay Delsing (R4/1993); sat 70th after a 6-over 76 in round one and played his last 36 holes in 12-under
- FedExCup leader **Jon Rahm** (T42/-3) posts a second consecutive 67 with birdies on four of his last five holes

- **Sam Burns** (T55/E) made a hole-in-one at the par-3 11th hole from 157 yards with a 9-iron, the second of his career on TOUR and second this season (U.S. Open/15th hole/R3)
