FedEx St. Jude Championship serves as the start of the FedExCup Playoffs - the entire season has built to this three-tournament stretch.

Moving Week at FedEx St. Jude Championship

Entering the 2009 FedEx St. Jude Championship, **Heath Slocum** ranked 124th in the standings. His victory vaulted him 121 spots to 3rd and secured a spot at the TOUR Championship (largest move in the 14-year history of the FedExCup Playoffs). In 2016, **Sean O'Hair** moved from 108th to 15th with his t-2 finish at the FedEx St. Jude Championship. O'Hair moved up 93 spots ranking as the 2nd largest move in any event in FedExCup Playoff history.

Last season, **Lucas Glover** moved up 87 positions during FedEx St. Jude Championship. Hoge moved from 121st to 34th (87 positions) before finishing 39th in FedExCup.
