**Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory**

Max Homa earned 500 FedExCup points with his third PGA TOUR win and first of two last season. Homa ranked #1 in the FedExCup standings for the first time in his career after his win at the 2021 Fortinet Championship and went on to finish Fifth in the final FedExCup Standings.

- 14** Max Homa played the weekend in 14 under, marking his career best score to par in the final two rounds of a TOUR event and three shots better than any other player at the 2021 Fortinet Championship.
- 72%** of Max Homa's total strokes gained for the week were a result of his tee to green play. Homa ranked Second in the field gaining +2.635 strokes in SG: Tee-to-Green per round.
- +10.54** Career-best Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green performance on TOUR

- 5<sup>th</sup>** PGA TOUR winner since the 2019-20 season to make an eagle on a par 4 in the final round en route to victory (12<sup>th</sup> hole)
- 2** With two PGA TOUR wins in California in 2021 (2021 The Genesis Invitational & 2021 Fortinet Championship), Max Homa is the first player since Tiger Woods (2008) to win twice in California in a calendar year.
