Rory McIlroy (1st/-10)

- 11th career 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (5-of-10 to date) and first since the 2020 BMW Championship (T12); 10 second-round leaders/co-leaders have won on TOUR this season
- With rounds of 64-66, cards a score of 66 or better in each of the first two rounds for the fifth time in his PGA TOUR career; has three wins and a runner-up in the previous four instances

- Third career 36-hole score of 130 or better in PGA TOUR career (others: 129/2014 Honda Classic/P2, 130/2012 Deutsche Bank Championship/Won)
- Eighth appearance in the Genesis Scottish Open (previous starts at The Renaissance Club: T34/2019, MC/2021)
- The Open Championship will be held at Royal Liverpool next week for the first time since McIlroy's victory in 2014

Miscellaneous notes

- **Tyrrell Hatton** (T2) records a 62, his career-low score on the PGA TOUR (previous: 63, twice; most recent: R3, 2020 FedEx St. Jude Championship at TPC Boston)
- **Tom Kim** (T2), who finished solo-third at the 2022 Genesis Scottish Open in his tournament debut, ties his career-low 36-hole score on the PGA TOUR (131); this is Kim's fourth 36-hole score of 132 or better and he went on to win two of the previous three instances (2022 Wyndham Championship, 2022 Shriners Children's Open)
- With scores of 67-66—133, **Padraig Harrington** (T7) records his eighth career 36-hole score of 133 or better on the PGA TOUR; the last time Harrington carded a 36-hole score of 133 or better on TOUR was at the 2015 Honda Classic (133), which he went on to win
- **Justin Walters** (back) and **Paul Waring** (back) withdrew during the second round
- **Nicolas Colsaerts** makes a hole-in-one at the par-3 14th, his first career ace on the PGA TOUR (45th career TOUR event)
- The leading three players, not already exempt, who make the cut will earn spots in next week's Open Championship
- Notable players to miss the cut: Ludvig Aberg (first MC in seven starts this season), Patrick Cantlay, Matt Fitzpatrick, Rasmus Hojgaard, Adrian Meronk, Jordan Spieth
