Rory McIlroy (1st/-13)

- 19th career 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (10-of-18 to date) and third of the season (2022 THE CJ CUP in South Carolina/Won, the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday/T7); ties Rickie Fowler and Wyndham Clark for most 54hole leads/co-leads on TOUR this season; 20 third-round leaders/co-leaders have won this season (most recent: Rickie Fowler/Rocket Mortgage Classic)
- Records a 54-hole total of 197 or better for the fifth time on TOUR (not including TOUR Championship)

- Has top-10s in each of his last five starts (T7/PGA Championship, T7/the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday, T9/RBC Canadian Open, 2nd/U.S. Open, T7/Travelers Championship), his longest such streak since he had seven straight in his last seven starts before the 2019-20 season was suspended due to COVID-19
- Eighth appearance in the Genesis Scottish Open (previous starts at The Renaissance Club: T34/2019, MC/2021)
- Seeks 24th career PGA TOUR victory to tie Gary Player and Dustin Johnson for 26th on the all-time PGA TOUR wins list
- The Open Championship will be held at Royal Liverpool next week for the first time since McIlroy's victory in 2014

Tommy Fleetwood (T3/-11)

- In eight previous appearances in the Genesis Scottish Open, has three top-10s, including two top-fives at The Renaissance Club (2nd/2020, T4/2022); 63 marks best score in 15 rounds at The Renaissance Club
- Six-time winner on the DP World Tour (most recent: 2022 Nedbank Golf Challenge) seeks first PGA TOUR win in 122nd start
- Has five runner-ups on TOUR; most recently lost in a playoff at the 2023 RBC Canadian Open
- Has 25 top-10s since the start of the 2017-18 PGA TOUR Season, second to only Brian Harman (29), among players without a win in that span; Harman is also T3

Miscellaneous notes

- Tom Kim (2nd) finished solo-third at the 2022 Genesis Scottish Open in his debut, marking his first top-10 on the PGA TOUR; has two wins since the 2022 Genesis Scottish Open: 2022 Wyndham Championship, 2022 Shriners Children's Open
- PGA TOUR rookie **Eric Cole** (T5) ties his career-low 54-hole score (199); also carded 199 at the 2023 Honda Classic where he lost in a playoff to Chris Kirk, his best finish in 30 PGA TOUR starts; can qualify for next week's Open Championship as one of the leading three players, not already exempt
- Scottie Scheffler (T5) leads the PGA TOUR with 14 top-10s this season and has finished T12 or better in each of his last 17 starts (next best player: 9/Jon Rahm)
