Today – An approaching upper-level disturbance will allow clouds to increase significantly this afternoon. A few showers are also possible after 5-6pm, however the lightning threat should hold off until after sunset. A period of northerly winds at 5-10 are possible this morning, otherwise winds likely become light and erratic by the afternoon. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.05".

Extended forecast – An upper-level disturbance will track over the Quad Cities tonight with showers/T-storms developing. The period between 12-6am Saturday should feature the greatest coverage of precipitation. Beyond any lingering precipitation Saturday morning (before 9am), dry conditions are likely for the remainder of the weekend. Winds should feature a northerly component Saturday/Sunday with velocities likely remaining under 15 mph.
