Extended forecast – An upper-level disturbance will approach the area late Friday into Friday night. Showers could reach the Quad Cities before sunset Friday, however the higher threat likely holds off until Friday night. Instability levels will be limited so the coverage of any T-storms remains questionable, if they occur at all. Beyond any lingering precipitation Saturday morning (before 9-10am), dry conditions are looking more likely for the remainder of the weekend. Winds should feature a northerly component Saturday/Sunday with velocities likely remaining under 15 mph.
