## 5 AM Weather Update

### Thursday, April 6, 2023



**Synopsis:** Patchy fog is a possibility towards daybreak this morning. Otherwise, mostly cloudy skies can be expected with temperatures in the 60s. A few showers and thunderstorms will develop out ahead of a frontal boundary after 3PM this afternoon with the chances continuing into the evening hours. There will likely be a lull in the precipitation overnight before the front is expected to slowly move through Central Georgia on Friday. Scattered morning showers will become more numerous in the afternoon. A few embedded thunderstorms are possible Friday afternoon as well. Breezy northeasterly winds behind the front will usher in colder conditions Friday evening, with temperatures holding in the upper 40s to low 50s throughout the day on Saturday. Waves of upper-level energy moving along the front will continue to produce periods of rain Friday night through Saturday, with bouts of heavy rain possible. Showers are expected to linger into Sunday morning before drier conditions finally return Sunday afternoon. Temperatures start off in upper 40s on Sunday before reaching a high in the low 60s.

4 PM: 30% chance of thunderstorms.  
Temp: 85F      RH: 50%  
Winds: SSW 5-10 mph

### Extended Outlook:

**Fri:** Cloudy with a 50% chance of morning showers. Rain chances increasing to 70% in the afternoon with a few embedded thunderstorms possible. Breezy after 3PM. Falling temperatures in the late afternoon. Rainfall: 0.50"  
Low: 62F      High: 75F      Winds: ESE 4–8 shifting NE 12–18 G 25 mph

**Sat:** Cloudy, colder, and breezy with an 90% chance of rain. Rain could be heavy at times. Rainfall: 1.00"–1.50"  
Low: 49F      High: 52F      Winds: NE 12–18 G 25 mph

**Sun:** Breezy with a 50% chance of early morning showers. Cloudy with lingering morning mist becoming partly sunny in the afternoon. Early morning rainfall: 0.20-0.30"  
Low: 47F      High: 62F      Winds: NE 12–18 G 25 mph
