TOP STORYLINES

World No. 1 and FedExCup leader **Jon Rahm** returns to the Mexico Open at Vidanta after winning the event in 2022. Rahm has four wins this season, including the Masters Tournament, and with a win, would become the first player to win five times in a season since Justin Thomas in 2016-17.

With \$13,623,540 in Official Money this season, Rahm is the second player in PGA TOUR history to earn \$13 million or more in a single season. In 2021-22, Scottie Scheffler set the PGA TOUR record for most Official Money earned in a single season (\$14,046,910).

Rahm has made six prior starts as the defending champion on the PGA TOUR. He has not successfully defended a title on TOUR, but led by six strokes after the third round of the 2021 Memorial Tournament presented by Workday before being forced to withdraw (COVID-19). Rahm has successfully defended one title on the DP World Tour, winning the Open de España in 2018 and 2019.

Tony Finau finished T2 at the 2022 Mexico Open, which was his first top-10 of the season. That runner-up result began a stretch of 15 starts for Finau that included three wins (3M Open, Rocket Mortgage Classic, Cadence Bank Houston Open) and three other top-five finishes. With his win at the Cadence Bank Houston Open, Finau is one of four players in the field that has won on TOUR this season.

Rahm and Finau are two of seven players in the field that finished in the top 10 at the 2022 Mexico Open, along with **Brandon Wu** (T2), **Cameron Champ** (T6), **David Lipsky** (T6), **Alex Smalley** (T6) and **Patrick Rodgers** (10th). **Sebastian Vazquez** (2016), **Austin Smotherman** (2018) and **Alvaro Ortiz** (2021) won the event when it was sanctioned by PGA TOUR Latinoamerica.

ADDITIONAL STORYLINES

95 players that competed at last week's Zurich Classic of New Orleans are in the field, including seven that finished in the top 10. **Wyndham Clark** and **Beau Hossler**, who finished third and held at least a share of the lead after each of the first three rounds, are both in the field, along with **Sean O'Hair/Brandon Matthews** (77), **Matthias Schwab/Vincent Norrman** (79) and **Martin Trainer** (finished T9 with Chad Ramey).

Brandon Wu carded a final-round 63 to finish T2 in 2022, tying Finau (R4) for the lowest score in any round. Wu earned his second career runner-up earlier this season at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.

At No. 35, **Andrew Putnam** has the third-highest FedExCup position of any player in the field behind Rahm and Finau. Putnam, who missed the cut at the 2022 Mexico Open, has two top-fives this season, highlighted by a runner-up at the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP. His lone TOUR victory came at the 2018 Barracuda Championship.

At No. 50, **Alex Noren** is the third-highest ranked player in the field via the OWGR behind Rahm and Finau. Noren is making his tournament debut at the Mexico Open and has one top-10 on TOUR this season (T4/Cadence Bank Houston Open). Noren is a two-time runner-up on TOUR and a 10-time winner on the DP World Tour.

All three players that have joined the PGA TOUR as Special Temporary Members this season are in the field (Akshay Bhatia, Ryan Gerard, Nicolai Hojgaard). To earn full status on the PGA TOUR for the 2024 season, those players must earn as many or more non-member FedExCup points as No. 125 in the final 2022-23 FedExCup Playoffs and Eligibility Points List, which will run through the FedExCup Fall.

Zach Bauchou, one of the four Open Qualifiers, is making his fifth career start on the PGA TOUR and first since the 2019 Rocket Mortgage Classic. Bauchou was a member of Oklahoma State's golf team that won the 2018 NCAA Championship along with current TOUR members Austin Eckroat (in the field) and Viktor Hovland.
