Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

Jon Rahm earned 500 FedExCup points and his seventh PGA TOUR Career win at the 2022 Mexico Open at Vidanta.

- 3** wins out of seven events when holding the 54-hole lead/co-lead (does not include 2021 the Memorial forced to W/D)
- 12** in Par 5 Performance, tied for the second lowest score on Par 5s at this event last season
- 340.5 yds** Jon Rahm averaged 340.5 yards off the tee on the two measured Driving Distance holes, his longest average in a TOUR event of his career and the fourth longest average on record by a TOUR winner (4-round events)
- +10.22** total Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green, the second highest total in his PGA TOUR Career
