Harrison Endycott (1st/-12) – CC

- Cards Sawgrass Country Club's low round of the day with bogey-free 5-under 65, his second bogey-free round of the week
- Has one bogey through 54 holes (par-4 18th/R2/Sawgrass Country Club), and is only player in the field with fewer than four scores of bogey or worse through 54 holes
- Holds two-stroke lead and sits five strokes ahead of last available position for PGA TOUR membership (currently 2-way T5 at 7-under 204)
- Earned exemption to Final Stage of PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry by finishing No. 139 on the 2022-23 FedExCup Playoffs & Eligibility Points List as a PGA TOUR rookie
- Earned first PGA TOUR card via the 2022 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, finishing No. 21 off the strength of a victory at the HomeTown Lenders Championship in what was his second season on Tour
- Converted his only 54-hole lead in PGA TOUR-sanctioned play into a win at the 2022 HomeTown Lenders Championship, where he carried a five-stroke lead into the final round and won by five strokes
- Making third career appearance at Final Stage of Q-School, having finished T41/2019 and T80/2021 at Final Stage of the Korn Ferry Tour Qualifying Tournament (now PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry)

Blaine Hale Jr. (2nd/-10) - CC

- Cards 3-under 67 with one eagle, two birdies, and one bogey at Sawgrass Country Club, sits two strokes off 54-hole lead and three strokes ahead of last available position for PGA TOUR membership (currently 2-way T5 at 7-under 204)
- Makes hole-out eagle at par-4 fifth, the only eagle recorded in Round 3 at Sawgrass Country Club
- Has just four bogeys and is one of only two players with fewer than five scores of bogey or worse through 54 holes (Harrison Endycott, one bogey)
- Has not previously held membership on any PGA TOUR-sanctioned tour
- Finished T26 as a sponsor exemption at 2022 Veritex Bank Championship on the Korn Ferry Tour, which is his only PGA TOUR-sanctioned start to date and earned him an exemption to First Stage of 2023 PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry
- Qualified for Final Stage of Q-School for the first time since he turned professional out of University of Oklahoma in 2019;
 he finished T4 at First Stage (Muskogee, Oklahoma site) and T5 at Second Stage (Valdosta, Georgia site) off the strength of a final-round 6-under 66

Spencer Levin (T3/-8) – CC

- Cards six birdies against two bogeys for third-round 4-under 66 at Sawgrass Country Club
- After opening with 2-over 72 at Dye's Valley, totals 10-under par in back-to-back rounds at Sawgrass Country Club with a bogey-free 6-under 64 in Round 2 and 4-under 66 in Round 3
- Seeking PGA TOUR membership for the first time since the 2016-17 season, which saw him finish No. 163 in the FedExCup standings; he has five career appearances in the FedExCup Playoffs (2010, 2011, 2012, 2015, 2016) and 17 top-10s in 244 career starts on TOUR
- Earned exemption for Final Stage of PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry with No. 50 finish on the 2023 Korn Ferry Tour Points List
- Captured his first PGA TOUR-sanctioned win at the Korn Ferry Tour's 2023 Veritex Bank Championship, where he won as an open qualifier
- Making seventh career appearance at Final Stage of Q-School, with three previous appearances at the PGA TOUR Qualifying Tournament (T42/2007, T53/2008, T23/2009) and three previous appearances at the Korn Ferry Tour Qualifying Tournament – which is now PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry (T92/2018, T69/2019, T45/2022)

Trace Crowe (T3/-8) - CC

- Stands inside the top five for second consecutive round after back-to-back rounds at Sawgrass Country Club, as he follows second-round 5-under 65 with third-round 2-under 68
- Makes four birdies and two bogeys en route to third-round 2-under 68 at Sawgrass Country Club
- Earned exemption to Final Stage of PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry with a No. 38 finish on the 2023 Korn Ferry Tour Points List
- Earned fully exempt membership for 2024 Korn Ferry Tour season with a win at the Korn Ferry Tour's 2023 NV5 Invitational presented by Old National Bank; he did not have a top-10 in his 28 career starts on the Korn Ferry Tour prior to his win
- Making third consecutive appearance at Final Stage of Q-School, finishing T91/2021 and T81/2022 at Final Stage of the Korn Ferry Tour Qualifying Tournament (now PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry)
- Turned professional in 2020 after four seasons at Auburn University (2015-19), where he won three individual titles and earned All-Southeastern Conference Second Team laurels in 2017 and 2019

Additional Player Notes

- Eight of the 12 players standing T10 or higher are seeking their first PGA TOUR card, and all of them will play Dye's Valley in the final round: Blaine Hale Jr. (2nd/-10), Trace Crowe (T3/-8), Jacksonville University alum Raul Pereda (T5/-7), Hayden Springer (T5/-7), Chris Petefish (T7/-6), Jacksonville resident Danny Walker (T7/-6), Ponte Vedra Beach resident Julian Suri (T10/-5), Isaiah Salinda (T10/-5)
- Three players shared the low round of the day at Dye's Valley Saturday with matching 6-under 64s: **Trey Winstead** (T13/-4), **Blake Elliott** (T19/-3), **Thomas Power Horan** (T24/-2)
- Five players who shot 74 or worse in the first round stand T36 or higher on the leaderboard through 54 holes:
 - Winstead (T13/-4 first-round 6-over 76 at Sawgrass Country Club)
 - o **Braden Thornberry** (T24/-2 first-round 6-over 76 at Dye's Valley)
 - Marcus Byrd (T36/-1 first-round 4-over 74 at Dye's Valley)
 - Alistair Docherty (T36/-1 first-round 8-over 78 at Dye's Valley)
 - Étienne Papineau (T36/-1 first-round 4-over 74 at Sawgrass Country Club)
- There were 11 players who rose more than 50 spots on the leaderboard in the third round, and all of them played their third round at Dye's Valley: Winstead (T13/-4 up 65 spots), Elliott (T19/-3 up 75 spots), Power Horan (T24/-2 up 85 spots), Patton Kizzire (T24/-2 up 54 spots), Thornberry (T24/-2 up 54 spots), Cooper Dossey (T36/-1 up 58 spots), Docherty (T36/-1 up 58 spots), Jeffrey Kang (T36/-1 up 58 spots), Ryan Hall (T54/E up 55 spots), John Lyras (T68/+1 up 54 spots), Austin Hitt (T91/+3 up 54 spots)
- **Keita Nakajima** (T54/E/CC), the highest-ranked player in the field in the Official World Golf Ranking (No. 90), falls 48 spots on the leaderboard with 5-over 75 at Sawgrass Country Club; he earned an exemption to Final Stage of PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry with a No. 1 finish on the 2023 Japan Golf Tour Order of Merit
- Nine players withdrew before, during, or after Round 3: Austin Cook, Rhein Gibson, Cody Gribble, Carter Jenkins, Kelly Kraft, Tain Lee, Sean O'Hair, Trent Phillips, Matthias Schwab

Final Stage Performance Benefits

- Top Five and Ties: PGA TOUR membership for 2024
- Next 40 Finishers and Ties: Exempt for multiple reshuffles of the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour season
 - The first 25 finishers and ties in this category will be subject to the third reshuffle, assuring them starts in the first
 12 events of the 2024 season
 - Any remaining finishers within the category will be subject to the second reshuffle, assuring them starts in the first eight events of the 2024 season

- Next 20 Finishers and Ties (following the Next 40 Finishers and Ties): Earn exempt status for the Latin America Swing of the 2024 PGA TOUR Americas season, in addition to conditional Korn Ferry Tour membership for the 2024 season
- All remaining finishers outside of the aforementioned categories earn conditional Korn Ferry Tour and PGA TOUR Americas membership for the 2024 season
