Today – A disorganized shower band continues to affect the Ponte Verda area, however this band will gradually shift northward as the morning progresses. Dry conditions are generally expected this afternoon but with onshore flow in place, a brief passing shower can't be ruled out. Otherwise, winds will remain brisk but will be weaker than yesterday. Peak gusts of 25-30 mph are expected. Forecast rainfall: < 0.05".

Extended forecast – Generally dry conditions tonight through much of the day Saturday, although a brief passing shower can't be ruled out. A Gulf low will develop Saturday and track across north Florida Saturday night. Rain likely develops late Saturday afternoon or Saturday evening and becomes heavy overnight. Rain should begin to diminish in intensity by sunrise Sunday and then completely end by early Sunday afternoon. 1-2" of rain is likely with localized amounts towards 4" possible. T-storms will also be possible, especially between 12-8am Sunday morning. As the low tracks away from the area, gusty northwest winds are expected to develop. Gusts over 40 mph could occur.
