Today – A few passing showers are possible through the early to mid-afternoon hours. Otherwise, the rain shield from a developing Gulf low will overspread the area after 4-6pm. Easterly winds will gradually increase, with winds gusting near 25 mph this afternoon. Temperatures should reach the lower 70s today. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.10".

Extended forecast – A Gulf low will track across north Florida tonight and then move offshore into the Atlantic Sunday morning. A period of heavy rain will affect the Ponte Verda area tonight, especially between 10pm-5am. Some lightning is also possible during this period. Rain will diminish in intensity very quickly around, or shortly after sunrise Sunday. Rainfall amounts between 2-3" are likely with localized areas possibly exceeding 4". Strong east/southeast winds gusting upwards of 35 mph are possible tonight, eventually shifting to the west or northwest between 8-11am Sunday. Gusts of 40-45 mph are possible once winds become westerly.
