Today – Rainfall overnight: 4.30". Low pressure will track across north Florida this morning and into the Atlantic this afternoon. Unfortunately, an extended period of dry conditions is unlikely today, although showers may diminish for period, especially between 9am-1pm. Otherwise, as the backside of the low moves overhead, steady showers should redevelop this afternoon. Winds will also increase significantly this afternoon with sustained speeds at 20-30 mph and gusting to 40 mph. Additional rainfall: 0.25-0.50". **Sunrise: 7:15am / Sunset: 5:27pm**
