**Today** – Northeasterly winds will become enhanced as high pressure to the north strengthens. Wind gusts of 35-40 mph can be expected by the afternoon hours, with Sawgrass CC more susceptible to these higher end gusts. While dry conditions are favored the first half of the day, shower bands should redevelop after 2-3pm this afternoon. There is some concern these bands become stationary as well. Forecast rainfall: Up to 0.25". **Sunrise: 7:13am / Sunset: 5:26pm**

**Extended forecast** – Onshore flow will diminish slightly by Friday with gusts generally in the 25-30 mph during the day. Passing rain showers will also remain possible but will be less persistent than Thursday. Attention then turns to a developing Gulf low this weekend. Significant model spread regarding the track of the system persists, which makes the wind forecast Saturday, and especially Sunday, difficult. Regardless of the track, a period of heavy rain will develop Saturday night into Sunday morning. 1-2" of rain appears likely with potential for amounts over 3" possible. Lightning potential will be dependent on the exact track of this system, so a low chance will remain in the forecast to cover this threat. As for the winds, there could be a period of wind gusts over 40 mph Saturday night into Sunday but confidence remains low.
