**TOP STORYLINES**

There are 14 players making their Presidents Cup debuts in 2022, which sets a record for most first-timers in one year. There are eight such players on the International Team (Christiaan Bezuidenhout, Corey Connors, Cam Davis, Tom Kim, K.H. Lee, Sebastian Munoz, Taylor Pendrith, Mito Pereira) and six for the United States (Sam Burns, Max Homa, Billy Horschel, Collin Morikawa, Scottie Scheffler, Cameron Young). Eight first-timers for the International Team is a Presidents Cup record for a single team (previous most: 7, 2013 and 2019 International Team).

The International and U.S. Teams are the youngest in team history, with average ages of 28.8 (INT) and 29.6 (U.S).

Two players in the field have won PGA TOUR events at Quail Hollow (both on U.S. Team): Justin Thomas, 2017 PGA Championship, and Max Homa, 2019 Wells Fargo Championship. Homa successfully defended his title at last week's Fortinet Championship, holing a shot from off the green for birdie at the 72nd hole to defeat Danny Willett by one stroke.

### International Team

At 20 years, 3 months, 1 day, Tom Kim, at is the third-youngest player to make his Presidents Cup debut.

Adam Scott will make his 10th career appearance in the Presidents Cup this week, the most by an International Team member in history. At 42 years old, Scott is the oldest player on the International Team and owns a 16-22-6 record, having competed in the second-most matches in Presidents Cup history (44).

Four players from South Korea are on the International Team, the most in Presidents Cup history, with Sungjae Im, Si Woo Kim, Tom Kim and K.H. Lee all competing. Prior to the 2022 Presidents Cup, the most Koreans to qualify for the International Team was three in 2011 (K.J. Choi, K.T. Kim, Y.E. Yang).

Players from 17 countries and territories have competed for the International Team at the Presidents Cup: Argentina, Australia, Canada, Chile, China (and Chinese Taipei), Colombia, Fiji, India, Japan, Mexico, New Zealand, Paraguay, South Africa, South Korea, Thailand, Venezuela, Zimbabwe.

### United States

World No. 1 and 2022 PGA TOUR Player of the Year Scottie Scheffler is one of six players on the U.S. Team making his Presidents Cup debut. Scheffler, who won four times during the 2021-22 season, has not competed in a PGA TOUR event at Quail Hollow.

Patrick Cantlay and Xander Schauffele compiled a 2-2-0 record as a team in the 2019 Presidents Cup, with both players making their debut that year. Cantlay and Schauffele won the 2022 Zurich Classic of New Orleans together and combined to win three individual titles on the season.

Jordan Spieth and Justin Thomas are the only two players on the U.S. Team with two or more career Presidents Cup appearances entering the week. Spieth is the most experienced player on what is the youngest U.S. Team in Presidents Cup history. As one of six captain's selections by Captain Davis Love III, Spieth is the eighth player in U.S. Team history to be a captain's pick more than once after being selected by Steve Stricker for his Presidents Cup debut in 2013 as a 20-year-old. Spieth has yet to win a Singles match at the Presidents Cup (0-3-0).
