## 2022 Presidents Cup: Round Three Results and Notes

### Things to Know

- The U.S. Team maintains their six-point lead after splitting round three Foursomes with the International Team
- Justin Thomas and Jordan Spieth improve to 3-0-0 as partners and seek to become the third pairing in Presidents Cup history to win four points in a single Presidents Cup
- Jordan Spieth improves to 7-0-0 in Foursomes, tying Adam Scott and Jim Furyk with the third-most wins in Foursomes
- Following a 3-and-2 victory with Hideki Matsuyama, Adam Scott has now secured at least one point in all 10 of his Presidents Cup appearances
- Tom Kim, the third-youngest player in Presidents Cup history, earns his first point teaming with K.H. Lee
- Max Homa joins Spieth and Thomas as the only players to win their first three matches
- Year-by-year scores after Round Three since the format for the third round changed to four points in 2015:
  - 2015: U.S. 7½, INT 6½
  - 2017: U.S. 11½, INT 2½
  - 2019: INT 9, U.S. 5
  - 2022: U.S. 10, INT 6

**Match 11: Jordan Spieth/Justin Thomas (U.S.) def. Sungjae Im/Corey Conners (INT), 4 and 3**

- Spieth and Thomas improve to 3-0-0 as partners and seek to become the fourth pairing to earn 4 points in a single Presidents Cup (Tiger Woods/Steve Stricker, 2009; Louis Oosthuizen/Branden Grace, 2015)
- Spieth earns his seventh Foursomes victory (7-0-0), tying him for third all-time with Adam Scott
- Thomas remains undefeated in six career Foursomes matches at the Presidents Cup (4-0-2)
- Conners misses a bogey putt from 12' 4" at the 15<sup>th</sup> hole to extend the match

**Match 12: Adam Scott/Hideki Matsuyama (INT) def. Cameron Young/Collin Morikawa (U.S.), 3 and 2**

- After sitting 2-down after the eighth hole, Scott/Matsuyama win the next five holes to clinch their first point of the week
- Scott's and Matsuyama's 2-up lead after the 12<sup>th</sup> hole marked the first time the International Team had taken more than a 1-up lead in any match this week
- Scott earns his eighth victory in Foursomes, tying him with Ernie Els for third all time (most: 12; Tiger Woods, Phil Mickelson)
- With the win, Scott has earned at least one point in each of his 10 Presidents Cup appearances
- 47<sup>th</sup> match played by Scott (second-most in Presidents Cup history; most: 55, Phil Mickelson)

**Match 13: K.H. Lee/Tom Kim (INT) def. Scottie Scheffler/Sam Burns (U.S.), 2 and 1**

- In a match comprised of four Presidents Cup first-timers, Kim holed an eagle putt from 36' 3" on the par-4 11<sup>th</sup> hole to take a 1-up lead; Kim/Lee never trailed for the remainder of the match
- Kim is the third-youngest player to compete in the Presidents Cup at 20 years, 3 months, 1 day (Ryo Ishikawa, Jordan Spieth)
- Kim/Lee holed the most putts from over 10 feet in round three (5)
- Kim/Lee are two of a record four players from South Korea on the International Team
- World No. 1 Scheffler suffers his second loss in Foursomes this week to fall to 0-2-1; Scheffler and Burns combined for seven victories on the PGA TOUR during the 2021-22 season
- Entering the week, the No. 1 player in the OWGR had competed in 11 of the previous 13 Presidents Cups with a total record of 32-18-4; only two players who competed in the Presidents Cup while at World No. 1 finished the week with two or less points (Nick Price, 1994, 0-2-2; Tiger Woods, 1998, 2-3-0)

**Match 14: Tony Finau/Max Homa (U.S.) def. Si Woo Kim/Cam Davis (INT), 4 and 3**

- Homa improves to 3-0-0 in his Presidents Cup debut and joins Jordan Spieth and Justin Thomas as the only players to win each of their first three matches; Homa has competed in the final match in each round

- Finau/Homa never trailed in each of their two Foursomes matches this week
- Finau wins both Foursomes matches in his second Presidents Cup appearance; Finau finished 0-1-3 in his debut at The Royal Melbourne Golf Club in 2019, including a 0-0-1 record in Foursomes
- Kim/Davis drop their first Foursomes match of the week after securing the International Team's only point in Thursday Foursomes

**Miscellaneous notes**

All matches are worth one point, for a total of 30 points. There are no playoffs, with each side receiving a half point if a match is tied after 18 holes. In a change inspired by the events of the 2003 Presidents Cup, if the match is deadlocked at the end of Singles play, the competition will be deemed a tie and the teams will share the Presidents Cup.
