**Today** – Mostly sunny skies with increasing westerly winds can be expected this morning. A cold front will push through Charlotte between 2-5pm. Shower/T-storm development is possible along the front, however this will remain sparse in coverage (10-20% chance). Otherwise, northwest winds will become a major factor, especially behind the front, with gusts approaching 25 mph after 4pm. A high near 94 degrees is expected. **Most likely rainfall: Less than 0.10". Sunrise: 7:11am / Sunset: 7:20pm**

**Extended forecast** – A fall-like airmass will settle over the area for Friday/Saturday with temperatures near, to slightly below normal. Winds both days should hold at, or below 15 mph. Another cold front will begin to approach the Carolinas late this weekend. The evolution of this front has changed considerably over the last 24 hours with a quicker, but weaker front, now favored. Given this, a low (15%) shower threat has been added to the Sunday afternoon forecast. If showers develop, rainfall amounts would be light, and lightning not expected. Wind gusts near 20 mph are possible during the day Sunday.
