Extended forecast – A cold front will arrive on Thursday. While this front will provide a sharp drop in temperatures, moisture and instability levels are meager. This should limit the coverage of afternoon showers/T-storms, with chances remained capped at 20%. Winds after 4pm Thursday could exceed 20 mph. Much cooler conditions will be in place Friday/Saturday with winds under 15 mph. Another cold front will begin to approach the Carolinas late this weekend, however this frontal passage most likely holds off until Sunday night or Monday. Winds Sunday afternoon may approach 20 mph.
