**Today** – Generally quiet conditions this morning with partly cloudy skies in place. The threat for showers should increase during the afternoon hours as a pocket of moisture reaches eastern Puerto Rico. Coverage likely remains scattered in nature with the highest threat (40% chance) between 2-4pm. Brief heavy downpours could occur. Brisk east/southeast winds will be in place with gusts of 20-25 mph likely much of the day. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.15". **Sunrise: 6:40am / Sunset: 6:29pm**

**Extended forecast** – Occasional patches of moisture will continue to move across Puerto Rico tonight into Saturday with just a few passing showers possible. Wind speeds will peak on Saturday with sustained winds over 15 mph and gusts over 25 mph. The highest moisture levels of the week are expected on Sunday, so shower coverage likely becomes more widespread and organized. The shower threat should diminish into Monday with weaker winds.
